Spring 2021 CH Youth Flag Football League - COVID Precautions, Restrictions and Guidelines

- **GAMES**

- **According to the latest health department guidelines, youth sporting activities are considered “events”, and are subject to the following:**
 - All participants are required to wear masks when entering/leaving the park.
 - Masks required at all times by non-participants.
 - *Coaches and players are encouraged to wear masks when on the sidelines.*
 - Coaches will symptom check their players upon arrival for each game, report accordingly to CHYFF staff.
 - CHYFF employees will be temperature and symptom checked prior to each game day.
- Additional requirements established by CHYFF management:
 - Two spectators permitted per player for games.
 - Players will not shake hands or give high-fives at the conclusion of games.
 - Players must bring their own water bottles and otherwise will not share equipment other than that essential to gameplay.
 - Flags and footballs will be disinfected prior to and after each game.

- **PARKING**

- Please help us be respectful of the local neighborhood and DO NOT park in the residential streets; **park in the Mill Hollow Park parking lot and if necessary, only along Hollow Mill Drive (6800 S).**
