

**Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center**  
Stick & Puck Coaching Agreement

**A Stick & Puck Coach** (herein referred to as *Coach* or *Coaches*) is a skating professional which is paid in exchange for their training services.

**All Coaches utilizing Stick & Puck sessions at the Cottonwood Heights Recreation Center (CHRC) must agree to the following:**

1. Coaches will pay a rate of \$12.00 per session and have permission to teach on Stick & Puck sessions only.
2. Coaches are responsible to pay their admission fee before each session begins and counts as part of the 30 skater allotment per Stick & Puck session.
3. Coaches are responsible for making sure their students pay appropriate admission fees before each session begins and can have no more than three students training together in one session.
  - a. *The 30 skater allotment is first-come, first-serve; incoming students are not guaranteed access to the rink as a result of their coach already being on the ice, should the allotment already be reached.*
4. Coaches cannot monopolize nets or block off sections of the ice as part of their training sessions; all skaters are allowed to use all nets and the entire sheet of ice.
5. Coaches and their students must abide by CHRC's "Rules of the Ice," as stated on respective flyers and as posted in Ice Arena Lobby and at entrances to rink.
6. Coaches assume their own risk (and that of their students) for their respective trainings and must carry current, appropriate liability insurance.
7. Coaches must abide by the PSA Code of Ethics & PSA Tenets of Professionalism, and must be a member in good standing with USFS and/or PSA, USA Hockey or US Speedskating.
8. Coaches must be willing to provide copies of insurance and/or membership records, if requested by CHRC.
9. Violation of facility rules or of any terms specified above will result in a written warning.
  - a. *After two warnings, Coach may be disallowed from accessing Stick & Puck sessions and/or trespassed from the facility, at CHRC's discretion.*
10. CHRC does not collect fees, coordinate lessons or advertise for Coaches.
11. CHRC additionally provides no obligation to Coach in regards to set or guaranteed ice time; session dates and times may vary month-by-month, schedules may change with little or no notice.
12. CHRC further reserves the right to disallow Coaches and/or students from accessing Stick & Puck sessions for any reason and may suspend or cancel sessions if rules are disregarded and/or the session's purpose is being abused.
